



Length of the border

Total -3298 km

External border -2260 km 68% (sea 865,7 km)

Internal border -1040 km 32%

- 20 police administrations
- police stations
- 6000 border police officers
- 350 police officers for irregular migrations

MIGRATION SITUATION - CHANGES

- 2000-2010- over 90 % migrants from the region - cultural and language similarities destination country for work
- After 2010 migrants from Asia and Africa
- Until September 2015 –5000 illegal migrants per year

MIGRATION CRISIS SEPTEMBER 2015 - MARCH 2016

- ▶ 16.09.2015 08.03.2016 more than 650.000
- 51 % Syria, 28% Afghanistan, 13 % Iraq
- ▶ 1000 families reunited, 22 asylum requests, 6 newborns and 2 deaths
- Cooperation with the Croatian Army, medical and social welfare staff
- RED CROSS, UNHCR, UNICEF, IOM, SAVE THE CHILDREN

ILLEGAL MIGRATION PRESSURE

- Land border, eastern border with Serbia
- Route: Serbia northern land border - Slovenia and Hungary
- Transit country migrants near their destination, not likely to give up and return
- Voluntary return rate low for migrants from Asia and Africa; high from the countries from the region (from other EU MSs and from Croatia)



Sea border

- Maritime country, long sea border
- Not affected by illegal migrations
- Only one case

CURRENT SITUATION

- Croatia is still transit country for most of migrants
- recent increase of illegal border crossing on border with Bosnia and Herzegovina
- with or without help of facilitators
- Foreigners with registered stay in EU members come to Croatia to facilitate migrants (family ties)
- request asylum, and disappear from Croatia
- Non-removable -still no AVR program



- Recording exit of third country nationals from the EEA – informing other member countries
