Integration is only marginally an EU competence, leaving aside the definition of legal migrants' rights. If the EU support policy is not considered as neutral, national policies are often the object of controversies like it is for the moment the case in the UK after the recent terrorist attacks. Belgium, seen the decentralisation of immigrant integration policies, is characterized by opposite integration models of the Flemish Community and the Walloon Region. This divergence internal to one Member State mirrors actually the European diversity: a continent without a 'European' model for integration, with only a modest input from the EU and of the case law of the Strasbourg and Luxembourg Courts. This debate aims at better understanding the situation in the EU through the lenses of Belgium with the help of two political sociologists (of course one Flemish - but from Brussels, and one French-speaking from Wallonia), the Mayor responsible for a commune famous in the entire world and a Flemish Member of Parliament, also former chef de cabinet of the Belgian prime-minister and engaged in local politics in Anwerp. The debate will be chaired by a Greek academic.
