#### **Fedasil**



- Federal Agency for the Reception of Applicants for International Protection is responsible for:
  - material aid: the agency organizes reception and support; also provides monitoring and guidance for unaccompanied foreign minors
  - the voluntary return, resettlement and relocation programmes

Fedasil promotes the integration of reception centres within the local community

## **Reception Network**













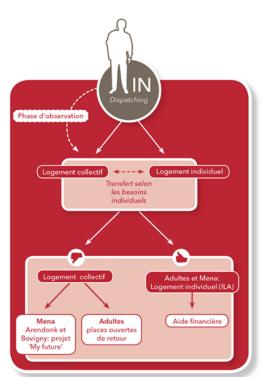




## Reception network



- Fedasil has a capacity of
   20.000 reception places
- collective reception centres & individual housing



### **Reception Capacity**



- in case of high influx 3 phased action :
  - phase 1: structural capacity
  - phase 2: buffer capacity
  - phase 3: extra capacity (reception partners, military accomodations, private operators, ...)

EPS/ indicators : <u>proposal</u> to activate next phase

# Capacity reduction after the migration crisis

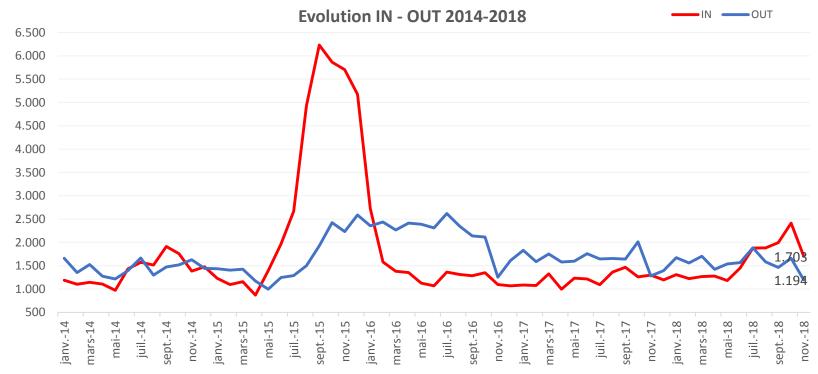
## After the migration crisis: the paradigm shift



- EU-Turkey deal as a symbol for a new political environment
- Inflow: more and more considered predictable and controllable
   less focus on contingency planning
- Mandate starts upon pre-arrival
- Change in target groups: focus on integration and pre-integration activities

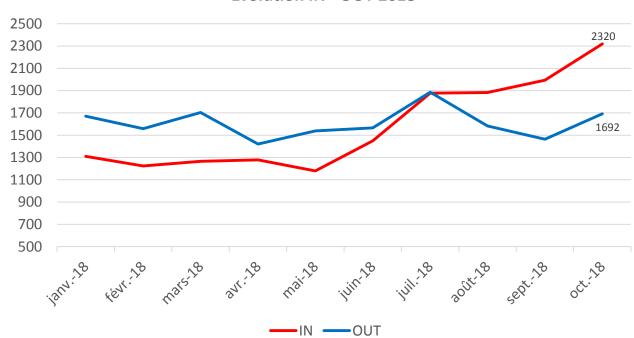

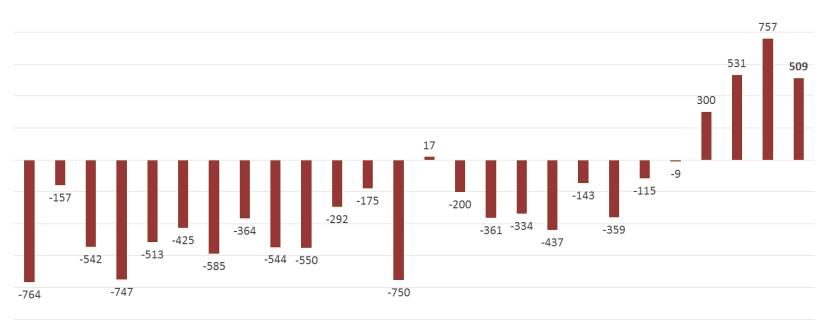








#### **Balance IN-OUT**

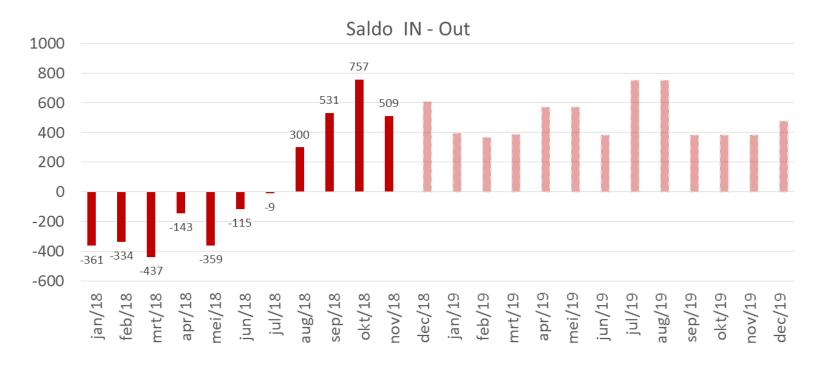


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#### **Balance IN-OUT: prognosis**





### Capacity reduction on hold

Increased inflow of applicants since July 2018.

Decision of the government (02 October 2018):

- postpone the closure of 7 reception centers foreseen in 2018 until 30 June 2019
- creation of buffer capacity



Many obstacles while constantly scaling up and down!



#### Resettlement on hold

26 October 2018: decision to postpone the resettlement programme because of high influx and occupancy rate in reception centres.

For 2018, Belgium had promised to accommodate a total of 1,150 refugees, mainly Syrians living in Turkey, Lebanon or Jordan.

880 refugees have already been resettled in Belgium this year, the 270 remaining refugees will be resettled in 2019.

## Why an Arrival Center?



#### Lessons learned from the last reception crisis

- Management of inflow and processes
- Need of more collaboration with immigration authorities

#### Improve the first arrival steps

- Screening of special needs of applicants
- Harmonisation of first. intake
- Reducing transfers during reception

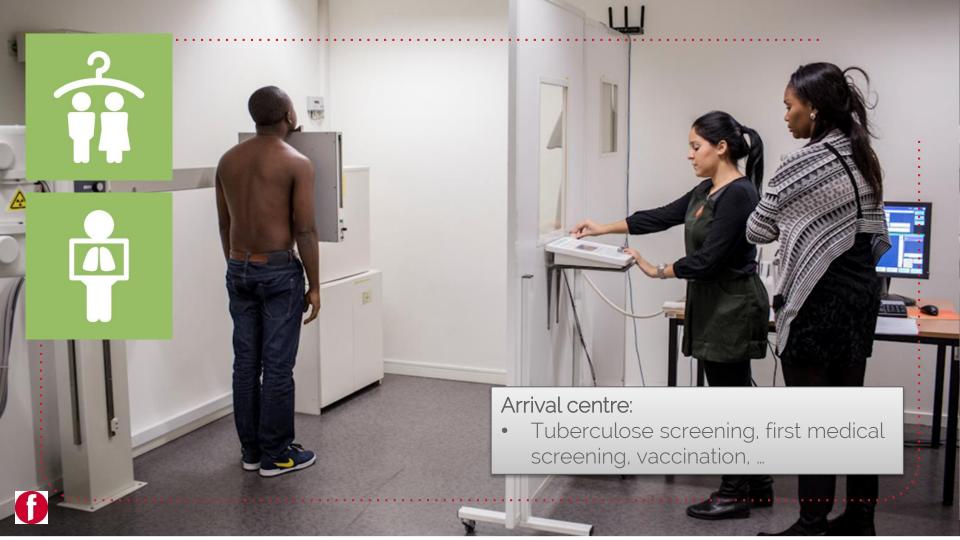
