


Immigrations of foreigners in Belgium





First residence permits (total) issued to TCN in 2010-2017, by year





56,246 first residence permits issued to TCN in 2017, by reason








EU-citizens and TCN - Family reasons 52,066 first residence permits for family reasons

According to the nationality of the beneficiary (top 10 nationalities 2017). Source data: Immigration Office. Graph: IV







2017: first residence permits family reasons

According to the affiliation between the person in Belgium and the family migrant (beneficiary)


According to the nationality of the person with residence rights in Belgium

Integration

- Pre-arrival integration measures in country of origin (SI)
- Civic integration policy in relation to refugees (NL)

Medical reasons

- TCN invoking state of health (FR)
- TCN applying for residence permits for medical reasons (FR)

Economic migration

- Economic migration policy regarding Low Skilled Workers (IE)
- The conditions of entry and residence of TCN for the purposes of EU Blue Card (SK)




