

<p>PRIVACY NOTICE IN THE CONTEXT OF THE REGISTRATION FOR EMN BELGIUM, ENABEL, IOM BELGIUM AND LUXEMBOURG'S EVENT OF 01 AND 02 JUNE 2022</p>

This privacy notice will explain how EMN Belgium uses the personal data we collect from you in the context of registering and attending EMN Belgium's Annual Conference on Skills Mobility Partnerships, organised in collaboration with Enabel and IOM Belgium and Luxembourg.

The processing and storage of your personal data is performed in full compliance with

- the European Regulation 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 (entered into force on 25 May 2018) on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data (GDPR);
- the Federal Data Protection Act of 30 July 2018.

On the basis of the provisions laid out in the GDPR, EMN Belgium, which falls under the Federal Public Service Internal Affairs, is responsible for the processing of your personal data. For the processing of data that is performed by IOM Belgium and Luxembourg, in the context of the registration of the event, EMN Belgium kindly refers you to IOM's privacy notice to which is referred when you register for the event (<https://www.iom.int/data-protection>).

What data do we collect?

Prior to our event (done by IOM upon registration)

During our event:

- Given that we record the event, you may appear in the film of the event;
- If given consent, your name may appear on the 'networking list' of the participants;

How do we collect your data?

By attending our event, you accept the possibility of appearing in our recordings/filming of the event.

For live-streaming the event we intend to use CleverCast (<https://www.clevercast.com/nl/>). For the privacy policy of CleverCast, please read: <https://www.clevercast.com/nl/privacy-policy/>. *Please note that Clevercast application **do not use Google Analytics**, its use is strictly limited to visitors of his website.". Data is stored on servers in the EU.*

How will we use your data?

EMN Belgium intends to include (part of the) videos of the event in its promotional material, which will be added to the EMN Belgium website (www.emnbelgium.be) and

to YouTube (<https://www.youtube.com/>). Also Enabel and IOM Belgium and Luxembourg may use part of the material. The sharing of the video on certain platforms, such as YouTube, may imply the application of the different platforms' cookie policies. The visitors of these platforms, when visiting the platform, will have to agree with the platforms' terms and conditions. Furthermore, YouTube is a third party that conditions the playback of its videos to the deposit of trackers on your browser, in order to be able to send you targeted advertising. Depending on your browser settings, some data may be saved on your computer. The cookies used will only appear if you choose to watch the video. For more information on this, we refer you to the YouTube cookie policy (<https://policies.google.com/technologies/cookies?hl=en>). If you do not wish to allow this deposit of third-party cookies, please do not watch the video or configure your browser in such a way that it refuses the deposit of third-party cookies.

Except for the latter exception, EMN Belgium shall not share your personal information with any Third Party.

How long do we store your data?

Your personal data will not be kept longer than necessary for the purposes for which they are stored, and that for a maximum period of 10 years.

What are your data protection rights?

EMN Belgium would like to make sure you are fully aware of all of your data protection rights. Every user is entitled to the following:

The right to access – You have the right to request EMN Belgium for copies of your personal data.

The right to rectification – You have the right to request that EMN Belgium correct any information you believe is inaccurate. You also have the right to request EMN Belgium to complete the information you believe is incomplete.

The right to erasure – If you consented to the processing of your data, you have the right to request that EMN Belgium erase your personal data.

The right to restrict processing – You have the right to request that EMN Belgium restrict the processing of your personal data.

The right to object to processing – You have the right to object to EMN Belgium processing of your personal data.

The right to data portability – If you consented to the processing of your data, you have the right to request that EMN Belgium transfer the data that we have collected to another organization, or directly to you.

Cookies

Cookies are text files placed on your computer to collect standard Internet log information and visitor behavior information.

We do not use cookies in the context of the registration of our event.
